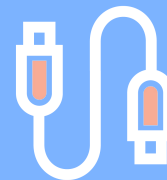
Connect live with students to maintain a personal relationship and explain complex topics.

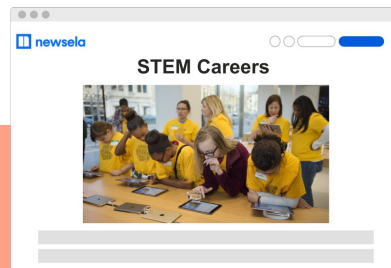
