Dear Families,

As you are aware, recent healthcare concerns have made it advisable for us to temporarily close school until we can be confident that students will be able to learn without fear of coronavirus transmission. To prevent learning loss during this time, we will be conducting classes remotely using Newsela, a website that adapts nonfiction articles at five different levels to make it possible for students of all proficiencies to read.

Each morning at the same time school would normally begin, we will share information about the task for the day. Here's what you can do to set up your child for success on this project:

- As much as possible, provide them with an uncluttered, quiet area where they can work
- Ensure they have a reliable connection to the Internet so that they can do their research
