





# New way to engage students


- New activity type – **polls!** – can activate prior knowledge and engage students at the start of a lesson

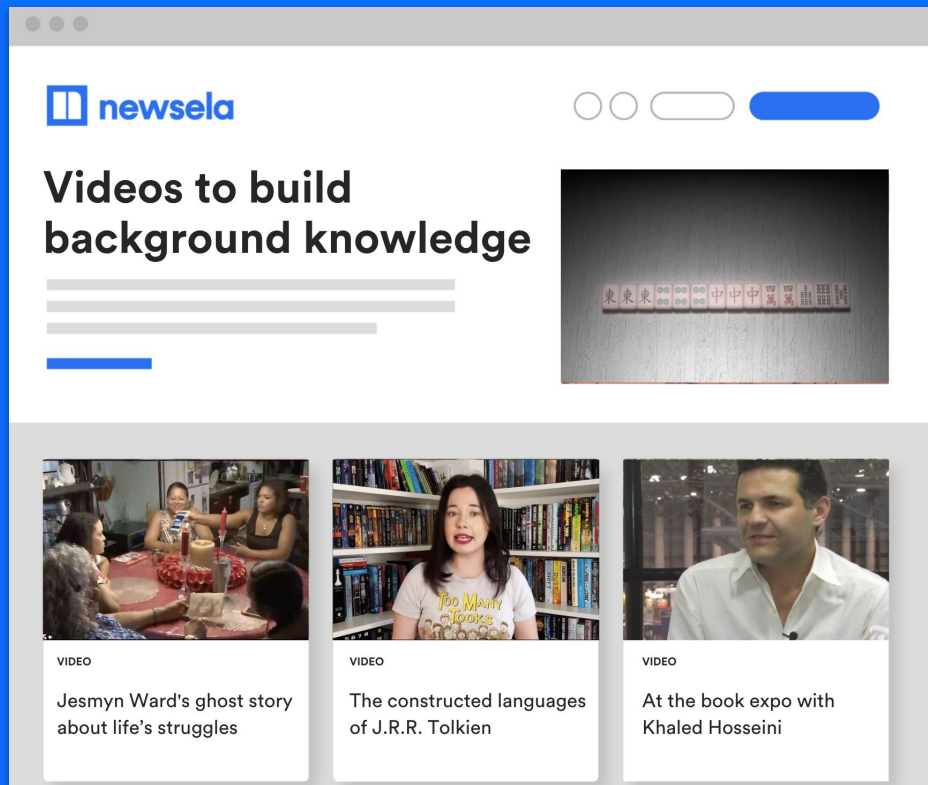
